**FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE**

**Wildwood, New Jersey** – County Prosecutor Robert L. Taylor and Chief Joseph Fisher of the Wildwood Police Department announced the culmination of a two month investigation conducted by members of the Cape May County Prosecutor's Office Narcotics Task Force, Wildwood Police Department and U.S. Drug Enforcement Administration.

At approximately 9:00 p.m. on December 15, 2006, members of the Narcotics Task Force, Wildwood Police Department SWAT team and Detective Division executed a search warrant at a residence located in the 200 block of East Lincoln Avenue, Wildwood, NJ. The search warrant resulted in the seizure of approximately one ounce of powder cocaine, drug paraphernalia and approximately \$6,668.00 in U.S. currency. The U.S. currency seized in the residence will be filed for forfeiture as proceeds from the sale of controlled dangerous substances.

Rubin David Rojas, 26 years-old, Leo Rojas, 30 years-old and Horlanda Vazquez, 24 years-old, all of the 200 block of East Lincoln Avenue, Wildwood, NJ, were arrested and charged with possession of cocaine, a third degree crime; possession of cocaine with the intent to distribute in an amount over one-half ounce, a second degree crime; and possession with the intent to distribute within 500 feet of a public place, also a second degree crime.

Rubin Rojas, Leo Rojas and Horlanda Vazquez were lodged in the Cape May County Correctional Center in lieu of posting \$75,000 cash bail respectively.

Prosecutor Taylor reported that on November 30, 2006, the same three individuals were arrested by the Narcotics Task Force and the Wildwood Police Department after a motor vehicle stop was conducted in front of their East Lincoln Avenue residence and approximately an ounce and a half of cocaine was seized along with packaging material and a digital scale. On this occasion, all three individuals were charged with possession of cocaine, possession of cocaine with the intent to distribute in an amount over one-half ounce and possession of cocaine with the intent to distribute within 500 feet of a public place. Leo Rojas was lodged in the County Correctional Center in lieu of posting \$15,000 cash bail while David Rojas and Vazquez were charged and released on summonses.

Persons convicted of a second degree crime may be incarcerated in New Jersey State Prison between five and ten years and a third degree crime between three and five years.
