Wildwood, New Jersey - County Prosecutor Robert L. Taylor and Chief Joseph Fisher of the Wildwood Police Department announced today the culmination of a month long investigation conducted by members of the Cape May County Prosecutor's Office Narcotics Task Force, U.S. Drug Enforcement Administration, and the Wildwood Police Department.

The investigation resulted in the August 4, 2006, arrest of Charles R. Daniels, 22 years old, of the 400 block of West Baker Avenue in Wildwood, New Jersey. Daniels was charged with possession of cocaine, a third degree crime; possession of cocaine with the intent to distribute in an amount over one half ounce, a second degree crime; and resisting arrest, a fourth degree crime. Additional charges are pending. At the time of Daniels' arrest, he was in possession of over one-half ounce of cocaine.

According to Prosecutor Taylor, Daniels is a suspected member of the Nine-Trey set of the Bloods Street Gang and has been living in North Wildwood and Wildwood for the past year with three other individuals, all suspected of being members of the Bloods. Prosecutor Taylor reaffirmed his commitment to target known or suspected street gang members involved in criminal activity in Cape May County, New Jersey.

Persons convicted of a second degree crime may be incarcerated in New Jersey State Prison between five and ten years, and a third degree crime between three and five years.
