Del Haven, New Jersey – Cape May County Prosecutor Robert L. Taylor and Chief Joseph Evangelista of the Middle Township Police Department announced the culmination of a two-month long investigation targeting the distribution of cocaine and diverted pharmaceuticals in Middle and Lower Townships, New Jersey.

During the early morning hours of May 18, 2007, personnel from the Cape May County Prosecutor's Office Narcotics Task Force, Middle Township Police Department, Cape May County Regional SWAT Team and Cape May County Sheriff's Department K-9 Unit executed a search warrant in the unit block of Pine Avenue in Del Haven, New Jersey, that resulted in the seizure of approximately six ounces of suspected powder cocaine with a street value of more than \$17,000.00, approximately seventy-five Xanax pills and drug paraphernalia.

Kimberly Eisele, 33 years old, and Frederic Eisele, 42 years old, both of the unit block of Pine Avenue, De Haven, New Jersey, were arrested and charged with possession of cocaine; a third degree crime, possession of Xanax with the intent to distribute; a third degree crime, possession of cocaine with the intent to distribute in an amount over five ounces; a first degree crime and possession of cocaine with the intent to distribute within 500 feet of a certain public place; a second degree crime. Both were lodged in the Cape May County Correctional Center in lieu of posting \$75,000 bail.

Prosecutor Taylor stated that persons convicted of a first degree crime may be incarcerated in the New Jersey State Prison between ten and twenty years. People convicted of a second-degree crime may be incarcerated between five and ten years and third degree crime three to five years.
