NARCOTICS SEARCH WARRANT EXECUTED IN WILDWOOD

Wildwood, New Jersey – County Prosecutor Robert L. Taylor and Chief Joseph Fisher of the Wildwood Police Department announced the culmination of a one month investigation conducted by members of the Cape May County Prosecutor's Office Narcotics Task Force, Wildwood Police Department and U.S. Drug Enforcement Administration.

At approximately 8:50 p.m. on November 3, 2006, members of the Narcotics Task Force, Wildwood Police Department SWAT team and Detective Division executed a search warrant at a residence located in the 100 block of East Roberts Avenue, Wildwood, NJ. The search warrant resulted in the seizure of approximately one half-ounce of rock cocaine, a variety of prescription pills to include Darvocet and anti-biotics, and approximately \$629.00 in U.S. currency. The U.S. currency seized in the residence will be filed for forfeiture as proceeds from the sale of cds.

Robert L. Evans, 26 years-old and Lorraine Pabon, 30 years-old, both of the 100 block of East Roberts Avenue were charged with possession of cocaine, a third degree crime; possession of cocaine with the intent to distribute in an amount over one-half ounce, a second degree crime; and possession with the intent to distribute within 1000 feet of the Wildwood High School, also a second degree crime.

Evans and Pabon were both lodged in the Cape May County Correctional Center in lieu of posting \$100,000 and \$75,000 cash bail respectively. Persons convicted of a second degree crime may be incarcerated in New Jersey State Prison between five and ten years and a third degree crime between three and five years.
