**Lower Township, New Jersey** - Prosecutor Robert Taylor and Chief Edward Donahue announced the July 30<sup>th</sup> arrest of Robert Geisel, 44 years old, who resides at the Norsdale Mobile Home Park located in Egg Harbor Township, New Jersey. Geisel was taken into custody by officers on Ocean Drive in Lower Township during the early morning hours of July 30<sup>th</sup>, and was subsequently charged with Criminal Trespass, a crime of the fourth degree. This charge specifies that the suspect was peering into the window of the victim's residence. Wildwood Municipal Court Judge David DeWeese set bail at 10,000.00 cash. Geisel was lodged in the Cape May County Correctional Facility in lieu of bail.

This arrest resulted from an month long investigation into numerous allegations of a "peeping tom" in the area of Lower Township and Cape May. Members of the Cape May County Prosecutor's Office, Lower Township and Cape May Police Departments are being credited with the timely arrest of Geisel.

Further investigation is being conducted into additional complaints, believed to be related to this investigation. Prosecutor Taylor is requesting anyone with information relating to similar incidents contact Detective First Class William Kirkbride at Prosecutor's Office or the Detective Bureaus of Cape May or Lower Township police departments.

Persons convicted of a fourth degree crime may be incarcerated in the New jersey State Prison between one and three years.
