Cape May Court House, New Jersey - Cape May County Prosecutor Robert L. Taylor and Middle Township Police Chief Christopher Leusner announce that a Press Conference will be held on Tuesday, November 22, 2011 at 2:00pm at the Cape May County Prosecutor's Office. The press conference coincides with the 20th anniversary of the disappearance of Mark Himebaugh.

Himebaugh, age 11 at the time of his disappearance, was reported missing by his mother after he failed to return home to his Del Haven, Middle Township home. Himebaugh was last seen in the Del Haven area during the afternoon hours of November 22, 1991. Since his disappearance, federal, state, county and local police agencies have cooperated in an extensive multi-state investigation. To date, the circumstances surrounding Himebaugh's disappearance have not been confirmed.

The Cape May County Prosecutor's Office, along with the Middle Township Police Department, the New Jersey State Police Missing Persons Unit, the Federal Bureau of Investigation, the National Center for Missing and Exploited Children along with the Himebaugh family continue to aggressively investigate this case.
