**Cape May Court House, New Jersey** – County Prosecutor Robert L. Taylor and Lower Township Police Chief Brian Marker, jointly announced the conclusion of a undercover narcotics investigation involving the Prosecutor's Office Gangs, Guns and Narcotics Task Force and the Lower Township Police Department Detective Division.

On February 01, 2012, members of the Cape May County Regional SWAT Team; Cape May County Prosecutor's Office and Lower Township Police Department, executed a court authorized search warrant at 27 East Pacific Avenue, Villas, New Jersey. During the course of the search of the residence several ounces of suspected marijuana were seized along with two imitation firearms and several hundred dollars of US currency. As a result of this investigation, the following subjects were arrested:

Mark A. Brown, age 37, of the unit block of East Pacific Avenue, Villas, NJ, was charged with 3rd Degree Possession of a Controlled Dangerous Substance (Cocaine), 3rd Degree Possession of a Controlled Dangerous Substance with the Intent to Distribute (Cocaine), 3rd Degree Distribution of a Controlled Dangerous Substance (Cocaine) within 1000 feet of School Property, 4th Degree Possession of a Weapon, 3rd Degree Unlawful Possession of a Weapon and 4th Degree Possession of a Weapon while being a Certain Person Not To Possess A Weapon. Bail was set by the Honorable Judge Robertson of the Lower Township Municipal Court in the amount of \$75,000.00 Full Cash

Devionne Graves, age 23, of the unit block of East Pacific Avenue, Villas, NJ was charged with 4th Degree Possession of a Controlled Dangerous Substance (Marijuana), 3rd Degree Possession of a Controlled Dangerous Substance with Intent to Distribute (Marijuana), and 3rd Degree Possession with Intent to Distribute Marijuana within 100 feet of School Property. Bail was set by the Honorable Judge Robertson of the Lower Township Municipal Court in the amount of \$35,000.00 Full Cash

Jonathan Foye, age 23, of the 500 block of North Wildwood Boulevard, Burleigh, NJ, was charged with Disorderly Persons Possession of a Controlled Dangerous Substance (Marijuana) under 50 grams and was released on a Summons.

Prosecutor Taylor advises that persons convicted of a third degree crime may be sentenced between 3 and 5 years in the New Jersey State Prison and persons convicted of fourth degree crimes may be sentenced to up 18 months in New Jersey State Prison.

Prosecutor Taylor acknowledged the cooperative efforts of both law enforcement agencies for the successful outcome of this investigation.
