#### **Bullying: The Silent Threat** **“Restoring Peace . . . One Child At a Time”**

- Bullying is a significant social issue affecting our children's quality-of-life.
- Expand your knowledge to enable early detection of the warning signs indicating those who bully and who are risk of being bullied and learn how to make a change.
- To examine personal biases, student sensitivity, and how a negative school climate increases bullying-related issues such as cyber bullying and sexting.
- Lastly to explore intervention and prevention strategies as related to bullying and school climate, school busses and playing fields and online.

#### **How Bullying Affects Children With Special Needs: “I Just Want A Friend”**

- Discuss the Predictors for Bullying,
- Types of bullying associated with Children with Special Needs,
- Student Centered Approach to Bullying and understanding the child's IEP/504 plan around bullying related issues.

#### **Teen Dating Violence**

Approximately one in three teens have experienced verbal, physical or sexual abuse in their dating relationships, nearly one in four have been abused through technology, and nearly one in two said they had been controlled, threatened, or pressured to do something they did not want to do. Teens involved in abusive relationships often feel trapped and powerless, and it is common for abusers to threaten the victim into compliance. This workshop will explore how normal adolescent development impacts teen relationships. The dynamics of teen dating violence, including red flags, victim and perpetrator risk factors, and protective factors will be examined. Participants will increase their knowledge base and ability to effectively support victims of teen dating violence and/or human trafficking. Interventions that can help teens get safe, stay safe, and have healthy relationships as well as resources for teens will be provided.

Dr. Claudio V. Cerullo is an internationally known Anti Bullying/ Anti Violence Expert, high school principal and founder and CEO of Teach Anti Bullying, Inc. Having been a former victim himself, Dr. Cerullo dedicated

his life to helping children and families who are affected by bullying and violence. He has been in education for 25 years as a K-12 administrator and spent 7 years in higher education. He has served with Gov. Ruth Ann Minner as her Director of Youth Mentoring. He has presented to over 80,000 children, parents, educators and law enforcement officials. He has written many children's books on the topic, In 2011, "Teach Anti Bullying: A Guide for Parents, Teachers and Students", In 2012 "Stop Bullying Me", In 2013 "My Name is David, I have Autism and I was Bullied", and in 2014 "It's Never Right To Fight" just to name a few. In addition, in 2015 Dr. Claudio V. Cerullo co-authored with learning expert Pat Wyman, "Amazing Grades 101 Best Ways to Improve Your Grades Faster." Cerullo's chapter is entitled, "Bullying and How it Affects Academic Achievement." In 2005 and 2011, he was invited to the White House as an expert panel member in the area of school violence prevention. He has received many awards and commendations such as the honor by the Philadelphia 76ers with the Heroes Among Us Award. In April 2017, his organization was nominated for the New Jersey State Governors Jefferson Award. Dr. Cerullo is currently working diligently with local police departments in cities such as Camden and Philadelphia to help "Bridge the Racial Divide" among young black men and our law enforcement.
